Join Dr. Suzanne Stoelting of Lindenwood University for a walking tour of The Hill, one of St. Louis's most historically rich neighborhoods. Originally settled by Italian immigrants in the late 19th century, learn how The Hill has preserved its cultural roots through generations of families who built homes, churches and businesses that still stand today. Each stop offers a glimpse into the faith, resilience, and pride that have defined The Hill for generations. Attendees will meet at 10:00am at Berra Park on The Hill. Join Dr. Colin Suchland of Lincoln Land Community College for lunch (pay as you go) followed by a tour of the historic St. Louis Courthouse and a visit to the Gateway Arch. The recently-renovated courthouse is the original site of the Dredd Scott case which led to the now infamous Supreme Court Decision in 1857. The Arch is the nation's newest National Park, with free admission to the museum and paid admission to ride 600 feet to the top of the Arch. Meet in the conference hotel lobby at 12:15.
